July 8 – **10:30 AM - 1:00 PM Mill Tour: Either high-tech or historic!**

First Congregational Church
4515 SW West Hills Road

Have you ever wondered how logs are processed? Come see the high-tech, computer optimized production in this tour of the Georgia-Pacific mill in Philomath. If, because of the economy, the mill is on standby, a tour of the historic Hull-Oakes mill 15 miles south of Corvallis may be substituted. For safety, wear long pants and closed-toe shoes. Everyone must wear high visibility vests, hard hats, ear plugs, and safety glasses, all of which will be provided. Everyone must sign a liability waiver at the mill. Tour has steps and requires walking. Meet at the First Congregational Church parking lot at 10:30 AM to carpool. The Starker Forests small bus can transport 14 participants, so the rest will need to car pool.

July 15 – *Judy Juntunen*– **Mount Union Cemetery Tour**

Mount Union Cemetery, Philomath

Join Judy Juntunen at Mount Union Cemetery, between Corvallis and Philomath. This is a beautifully well-kept cemetery whose grassy knoll provides inspiring views of the surrounding countryside. Though historical, the cemetery is still currently in use, so one finds a mix of old, crumbling and sometimes artfully decorated monolithic monuments among modern, low-lying utilitarian gravestones. Judy will share with us stories of the pioneers in the area who are buried here, and explain the unusual policy as to who could be buried in this cemetery. It is strongly recommended that you bring something to sit on — a seat or pad or whatever suits you - and carry sun protection.

Directions: From Philomath Blvd. and 53rd St. drive south on 53rd about 0.8 mi. Turn right on Plymouth Dr. (there is a church on the NW corner), and go west about 1 mi. to a four-way stop. Turn right onto Mt. Union Drive and proceed up the hill. Parking is along the right side of the road — there is a subdivision on the left.

July 22 – *Tom McClintock*– **Corvallis' Best Gift**

Corvallis Public Library

Tom McClintock, OSU Professor Emeritus of History and author of *The Best Gift* will discuss his book about Corvallis's best gift. Tom will share the story behind the writing of this book on libraries and specifically Corvallis' library as well as some of the interesting discoveries he found during his research for this book. The class will meet in the main floor meeting room of the Corvallis Public Library (645 NW Monroe). The class will conclude with a tour of the public art in the building and a demonstration of some of the latest technology available in the library.

July 29 – *Chris Anderson*– **Learning to Make Intuitive Leaps, in Poetry and in Life.**

First Congregational Church

Chris Anderson will read poems from his new book of poetry, *The Next Thing Always Belongs*, and guide you in the making of your own intuitive and imaginative leaps. Class will be interactive, relaxed, and informal. Bring paper and pen. Chris Anderson is a professor of English at Oregon State University, a poet, and a Catholic deacon. This class will be held at the ALL meeting room of the First Congregational Church.

August 5 – *Elizabeth Helman*– **Shakespeare and Commedia dell'Arte**

OSU - Withycombe Hall

In support of the Bard in the Quad 2009 production of Shakespeare's Twelfth Night, Elizabeth Helman, OSU Department of Theatre Arts and Director of this year's Bard on the Quad production of *Twelfth Night*, will present the history of Italian professional renaissance theatre (commedia dell'arte), explore its influences on Shakespeare's comedy, and discuss the production's concept. This class will meet in the lab theatre in Withycombe Hall (NW Campus Way and 30th St).

August 12 – *OSU Staff*– **OSU Engineering Buildings Tour**

OSU - Kearney Hall

We will first tour Kearney Hall, learn about its amazing transformation from the old Apperson Hall to the “new” Kearney Hall by removal and recreation of the interior. OSU was thus able to retain the beautiful facade of the old building, with appropriate architectural and safety updates inside. We will enjoy the art that has been incorporated, and explore the state-of-the-art classroom and support areas. Then we will walk to the Kelley Engineering Building. This was the nation's first gold LEED academic engineering building. It provides state-of-the-art research laboratories, classrooms, and office space for the School of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science. There will be a discussion of the LEED gold rating, pointing out the aspects of the building that assured this rating, the art work incorporated in the design, and the interior designs that have also won awards. Meet in the lobby of Kearney Hall (NW 14th and Campus Way). This class will be approximately 2 ½ hours with a
