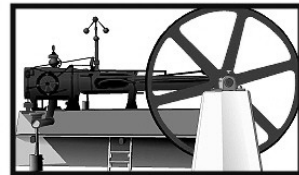

June 19 9:30AM Playing for the Freeway Philharmonic: Life as a Freelance Musician Corvallis

Dr. Lara Wickes makes her living playing the oboe in Southern California. This takes her from San Diego to Santa Barbara, from symphony halls to recording studios, from TV shows to Carnegie Hall. Her audiences range from a few people at a chamber concert to many millions in a major motion picture. She will share with us the joys, pressures, and fears of a life where every day is different, and talk about how she manages marriage, motherhood, and mundane matters along with making beautiful music. We will learn about live performances, and about movie soundtrack recording—where there are no rehearsals, film clips play in the background, and the composer might be revising the score on the fly. Lara will also teach us about her peculiar specialty instruments, the oboe and the Theremin. This class is being held at the First Congregational Church, 4515 SW West Hills Rd.

June 28 1:00PM Introduction to Forensic Science [LIMIT 24 Participants—Must Be Registered To Attend] Monmouth

This course will outline some of the most current techniques and practices within Forensic Science. The course will be presented with an introductory lecture, approximately 30 minutes in length, followed by several hands-on activities that will be set up in stations. These include blood spatter analysis, fingerprint dusting and identification, and introductory microscopy skills. Class location: Western Oregon University, Natural Sciences Building, Room 115, 345 N. Monmouth Avenue, Monmouth, Oregon 97361. A parking fee of \$2 may be required.

July 10 10:00AM Jensen Arctic Museum Tour Monmouth

Have you ever wondered what life is/was like in the Arctic? Here's your chance to learn about the arctic culture, lifestyles, and habitat at the Jensen Arctic Museum in Monmouth, Oregon. This is the only museum on the West Coast that is dedicated wholly to the arctic culture. The museum's collections include art, tools, apparel, and information about indigenous arctic people. The Jensen Arctic Museum lends an appreciation for both the culture and ingenuity of a People who blended into a difficult and often unforgiving arctic environment.

July 17 1:30PM Tour of Benton County Courthouse and Jail Corvallis

Recently retired Benton County Elections Administrator and courthouse historian, Jill Van Buren, will explain the history and activities of the oldest active courthouse building in Oregon. Two groups will alternate touring the courthouse and the county jail. An optional visit to the courthouse tower will require some climbing. We will meet in front of the Courthouse, 120 N. W. 4TH St., Corvallis, at 1:30.

July 24 1:30PM Tour of Old Fort Hoskins Kings Valley

A tour of the Fort Hoskins Historical Park in Kings Valley will be conducted by David Brauner, Oregon State University Archeologist and Chair of the Fort Hoskins Citizen Advisory Committee. The fort was established in 1856 as a garrison of the 4th Army Infantry Regt., and was held by the California and Oregon Army Volunteers during the Civil War. Professor Brauner has led 5 archeological digs at the site. The former Commandant's house was returned to its original location last year. The park is located 19 miles northwest of Corvallis, at 38150 Hoskins Road. From Philomath, continue west on Hwy 20 for 4 miles to Hwy 223, Kings Valley Rd.. Turn right and go north 6 miles to Hoskins Rd. (Rural Fire Protection Station is at intersection). Turn left and go west 2 miles to Fort Hoskins. We will meet in the Fort Hoskins parking lot at 1:30.

July 31 1:30PM Tour of Hatfield Marine Science Center Newport

Class will meet in the Marine Science Center Visitors Center at 2030 SE Marine Science Dr., Newport, Oregon, at 1:30 PM and will then have 15 minutes to explore the self-guiding displays there. At 2:15 we will gather in the auditorium for a welcome and overview of the facility and its many programs by Maryann Bozza, Marine Center Program Manager. There will then be a presentation on stage and in the Visitor Center by a staff member about the Free Choice Learning Lab. A generous grant from the National Science Foundation has allowed the Center to install a research infrastructure within the Visitor Center, using emergent technologies to study behavior, capture responses and adapt content to visitor needs. We will then continue touring the rest of the campus with Maryann, ending at 3:30.

August 6 10:00AM Antique Powerland Steam Park Brooks

Fieldtrip to Antique Powerland Steam Park. Ride a steam train and perhaps a trolley or tractor. There are early day machines, blacksmithing, and threshing operations to see. Gain an appreciation of our agricultural heritage and how the early machines improved lives. There is a \$5 suggested donation entry fee and \$3 suggested donation for rides around the park. Bring a sack lunch or money to purchase lunch at the Chalet Restaurant. Take exit 263. Turn west toward Pilot sign. Cross over I-5. Theme park is to the right (on Huff Ave.) next to May Trucking Co. and past the Chalet restaurant.

August 14 9:30AM Comedy of Errors—OSU Summer Bard in the Quad—Director's Insight Corvallis

Twins, mistaken identities, Shakespeare's most violent character, and a touch of romance all add up to a memorable experience. Join us at Withycombe Hall--Theater Lab where Elizabeth Helman, Visiting Instructor, will present insights to enhance enjoyment of the OSU performance of the *Comedy of Errors*.
